

The 2019 PMC Champion Award for Pyramid Model Implementation

The Pyramid Model Consortium (PMC) is excited to announce a call for the second annual PMC Champion Award. Through this award, PMC aims to recognize individuals or teams who embrace and demonstrate the Pyramid Model in action through their sustained and impactful implementation of the Pyramid Model in homes, schools, and community settings to support children, birth to 5 years and their families.

We want to highlight exemplary individuals or teams who have a demonstrated record of implementing with fidelity, the Pyramid Model at the program or local, state, regional, or national level.

Eligibility:

- An individual or team of individuals who support children, birth to 5 years old and their families using the Pyramid Model.
 - *If selected, the nominee or a designate is encouraged to be in attendance at the NTI conference to receive the award.*
- PMC members, current and past board members, full/part time employees/staff including consultants and trainers paid through PMC are not eligible.

Nomination Process:

- Any individual who has first-hand knowledge of the work of the nominee regarding the implementation of the Pyramid Model can submit nominations.
- Self-nominations will be accepted.
- All nominations will be confidential.

Required Documentation:

The following must be saved and uploaded as one (1) PDF file (*no more than 5 pages total*):

- A 300-500 word description of how the nominee stands apart from others who also implement the Pyramid Model. The description should include how the Pyramid Model is being implemented and evidence of its impact on children and families.
- Maximum of three (3) letters of support.
- Supplemental documentation of Pyramid Model implementation.

Selection Criteria:

1. Demonstration of **successful implementation** of practices across all levels of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. *Clear and tangible evidence of implementation of the Pyramid Model, with fidelity (e.g., data, testimonials, and other measures demonstrating proof of successful implementation).*
2. Demonstration of **sustained implementation** of practices across all levels of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. *Clear and tangible evidence that the implementation of the Pyramid Model has been ongoing and sustained for over two or more years.*
3. Demonstration of nominee's **significant contributions to the broader community or field** through the implementation of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. *Clear and tangible evidence that the nominee has had a positive impact on children, families, program, and/or community with their use of the Pyramid Model (e.g., data, testimonials, and other measures demonstrating proof of impact).*
