Workgroup Selection

Individuals interested in supporting the work of the State Leadership Team (SLT) are asked to first join one of four standing workgroups. As openings occur on the SLT, new members will be selected from workgroup participants to ensure representation of diverse perspectives.

Communications Workgroup

Develop and create marketing and outreach materials including PowerPoints, web-presence, social media, etc. This workgroup will ensure stakeholders are aware of all professional development opportunities and on-going ways to be connected to the work of the State Leadership Team.

Data Workgroup

Ensure the needed data are available to effectively evaluate the impact of the State Leadership Team. This workgroup will assess what data already exists in the state and what data the State Leadership Team has access to. In addition, this workgroup will coordinate the development of additional data tools and procedures as needed.

Implementation Workgroup

Support the infrastructure needed to develop and create high-fidelity implementation sites who are committed to Program-wide and/or Community-wide Implementation. This workgroup will develop a process for recruiting and launching cohorts of agencies developing high fidelity sites.

Professional Development Workgroup

Develop the process for creating a Master Cadre of trainers and coaches and external facilitators of programwide Leadership Teams. This workgroup will be the hub of coordinating the on-going in-service work around the Pyramid Model. In some states, this workgroup works to coordinate with Higher Education efforts and/or efforts to link to Infant Mental Health endorsement/credentialing.
