How to use this guide

Two tools in one document: a map of what PIDS contains, and a map of who can see and do what.

PART 1 — SITE MAP

The pages that follow list every dashboard in PIDS, in the same order as the PIDS navigation menu, along with the components (sub-sections) found within each one.

Use this section to get oriented: which dashboards exist, what each one is for, and what components live inside it.

PART 2 — ROLE-BASED ACCESS GUIDE

PIDS access is organized into four levels — **Program**, **Coach**, **Hub**, and **State** — plus a small **National** tier for PMC's own reporting. Each level contains several roles, and each role has a different combination of permissions: whether it can view child names, view teacher names on TPOT/TPITOS forms, add/edit/delete forms, and add or view uploaded files.

Use this section to decide which roles fit which staff, coaches, or partners at each level of your implementation.

PLANNING YOUR IMPLEMENTATION

As you review both sections, consider:

- Which dashboards does your program plan to actively use first, versus later?
- Who on your team needs data-entry access (Data Collector-type roles) versus view-only access (Detail/Aggregate Viewer roles)?
- Which staff need access to child-identifiable information, and which do not?
- Do any external coaches or hub/state partners need visibility into your program's data?

Note: Check with your PIDS administrator for the current status of any dashboard before finalizing your access plan, as some sections are still being built out in the live system.
